
Dear parents and carers,

Please find below an outline of Year 5's curriculum for this half term. If you have any questions regarding the curriculum this half term then please speak to one of the team.

English

History

In history we will be looking at the Anglo-Saxons, Scots and Vikings; deepening our knowledge of what happened after the Romans left the UK.



We will be looking at the impact of climate change on the different aspects of the world. To link with our science, we will be looking at stories that show the impact of climate change on endangered animals.



<u>Maths</u>

In Maths we will be learning all about place value. In particular, we will be focussing on numerals to one million along with addition and subtraction with 4-digit numbers.









Philosophy

In Philosophy, we will be contributing our own ideas and opinions in appropriate ways, relating to different stimuli.



Religious Education

Why do some people believe God exists? During this topic, we will be exploring what God means to people who worship different religions and how they worship their God.



Physical Education

In PE this half term we will be learning about the skills needed to play netball. We will focus on the different types of passes used within this game and how to manoeuvre around the court.



Computing

We will be using computing to throughout our lessons help practice our basic computing skills such as copy and pasting, searching and how to present our



Science

In science we will be looking at living things and their habitat. We will look at the life cycles of different animals and how plants reproduce. We will look at endangered species and what their habitats are like.



Art

In art we will be looking at impressionism. We will be looking at the work of Claude Monet, Pierre-Auguste Renoir and Erin Hanson; using their work to inspire us to draw and paint own our landscapes.





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French

Bonjour Year 5!
In French we will be re capping numbers, shop names and directions. We will do lots of speaking as well as learning to write in French.



PSHE/TTT

In PSHE/TTT each week the children discuss current news events and PSHE topics such as healthy eating, dealing with difficult situations and aspirations and dreams amongst many. In order to develop children's thinking and questioning skills, children will also continue to have Philosophy sessions. This has proved very beneficial and has developed the children's ability to work in groups and value other people's opinions and views.

Enrichment

In Enrichment, pupils generate patterns for creative proficiency, build good character, initiate an engaged mode for learning, and find purpose and interest in foundation subjects such as Food Technology, Art, Drama, Expressive Arts and Earth Adventures.
