Dear parents and carers,

We have had a fantastic first half term in Year 1; getting to know your children and what they enjoy, learning new routines and settling in! Please find below an outline of Year 1's Curriculum for this next half term. We will be working hard on our basic number and literacy skills, phonics and continuing to learn the rules and routines of year 1.

The areas of learning for **Year 1** this half term (Autumn 2) are:

Social Skills

We will be playing lots of games to support the children building relationships, taking turns and getting to know each other again.



English

We will be teaching daily phonics to the children focusing on letter recognition, tricky words and letter formation. We will be looking at the book 'Nibbles the Book Monster'- exploring the genre of Traditional Tales.



Maths



In Maths, we are building our mental and written methods of addina and subtracting within 10. We will also be lookina at shape.

PSHE/Time To Think (TTT)

In PSHE and Time To Think, we discuss current news events and PSHE topics such as our emotions, our human rights, problem solving and staving safe both online and in the real world.



Forest School

Each term 10 children from the class will go out to do Forest School. In addition to this the children will also access extra outdoor learning time with their class teacher and the Forest School team



Physical Education

In P.E we will be exploring the dance genre; Hip Hop! We will be looking at the different types of music and dance moves-collating these together and performing for our grown-ups in our 'Hip-Hop Holiday' Christmas performance.



Science

Now we understand how to be a scientist we will start to explore different elements of science. This half term we will look at the Human Body-learning about muscles, bones, joints and how we can keep our bodies healthy.

History

In History we will continue to learning about the Great Fire of

London. In this half term we recognise that It will be




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Remembrance Day, we will learn about why we reflect on this time.





Useful notices

- We ask that the children are reading a minimum of 3x per week at home on Active Learn, your class teacher will allocate books (linked to the phonic sound) every Friday. We ask that each time your child reads it is documented in their Reading Record, this will be checked by the class teacher every Friday. This is a great way to communicate your child's reading progress.
 - Maths Link Learning will be sent home **every Friday** and should be completed by the **following Thursday** and handed in to the class teacher.
 - Alongside this, spellings (linked to the phonic sounds) will be handed out every Friday, these need to be practised at home ready for the children to complete a 'spelling quiz' the following Friday.
 - P.E day will be on Monday. Both 1L and 1T have PE on a Monday this half term. Children are required to come in full PE kit on this day (please see school website for correct Lime Tree P.E kit).
