Please find below an outline of Year 5's curriculum for this half term. If you have any questions regarding the curriculum this half term then please speak to one of the team.


Geography

This half term we will be moving onto Geography. Our Geography will focus on North America. We will revisit our knowledge of countries and continents before focussing on the physical and human features of different countries in North America.



English

Our new English genre for this term will again be based around adventure however, this book will inspire the children with the wonder of space and open their eyes to a world of possibilities.



Maths

Our learning in maths this half term will focus on both decimals & percentages and perimeter & area. We will be extending our learning within these topics by applying it to real life scenarios.





Philosophy

In Philosophy, we will be contributing our own ideas and opinions in appropriate ways, relating to different stimuli.



Religious Education

In R.E we will be looking at the Easter story. We will be exploring ways that various people celebrate Easter as well as exploring the foods associated around this event.



Physical Education

In PE, we will be refining our gymnastic skills by looking at how we can use apparatus safely to link movements fluently and practising our coordination. We will also look at a range of gymnastic sequences to enhance our own performances.





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Computing

This term in computing, we will be looking at creating media, in particular, video production. We will be investigating various ways in which we can create videos which are both education and for fun.



Science

In line with the focus of our English book, Science will be delving deeper into Earth and Space. We will be examining the movements of planets within the solar system, solar systems within our universe, and why we have such things as day and night.



Design Technology

In Design Technology this half term, we will be looking at structures. We will be investigating different bridges across the world and the foundations which underpin these with the penultimate aim to design and make our own bridge!



French

In French this term, we will be recapping the new vocabulary we have been learning over the previous term and putting these new words into sentences.



PSHE

In PSHE we will continue to build on our learning to know how to deal with emergencies. We will then be looking at how to communicate safely and effectively with our friends to help us deal with a range of different social situations.



Enrichment

In Enrichment, pupils generate patterns for creative proficiency, build good character, initiate an engaged mode for learning, and find purpose and interest in foundation subjects such as Food Technology, Art, Drama, Expressive Arts and Earth Adventures.
