History

After finishing Geography, we will be moving on to history this half term. We will be looking at ancient civilisations, focussing on the Islamic empire and how modern it was.



Key vocabulary: scholar, merchant, manuscript, mosque, trade, Baghdad, Caliph, House of Wisdom, Muhammad, empire, legacy

English


This half term we will be starting our persuasive writing unit. We will be inspired by our new book which looks at how we can care for our environment.



Key vocabulary: vanished, emerged, gathered, jammed, thundery, managed, scavenge, responsible, attention, Refrigerators, carriage, steam engine, council, rubbish dump, stove, machine, brambles, paradise poison

<u>Maths</u>

In maths this half term our focus will be on shape! We will be focussing particularly on angles and lengths in different shapes. Then, we will move on to looking at position and direction of shapes, looking at coordinates and lines of symmetry.



Key vocabulary: angle, whole turn, right angle, acute angle, obtuse angle, clockwise, anticlockwise, orientation, reflection, translation, vertex, vertices, coordinates, mirror line, horizontal axis, vertical axis

Philosophy

In Philosophy, we will be contributing our own ideas and opinions in appropriate ways, relating to different stimuli.



Religious Education

In R.E we will be looking at different places of workship and trying to answer the question; "if God is everywhere, why do people go to a place of worship?"

We will study the places of worship of different Christian denominations as well as looking at the duty of pilgrimage in Hinduism.

Physical Education

In PE, we are lucky to have a coach from Brooklands Lacrosse joining us for our PE sessions. They will remind us of the basics of lacrosse and we will play lots of games and mini matches.



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Key vocabulary: Community, synagogue, deity, worship, Anglican, Baptist, pilgrimage, shrine, Mosque

Key vocabulary: lacrosse, ball, scoop, pass, dodge, defend, face off, check

Computing

Within computing this term, we will be learning create a programme in the aim to control a computer project. We will be looking at circuits to help us create these programmes.



Key vocabulary: microcontroller, Components, connection, infinite loop, output component, motor, repetition, count-controlled loop, crumble controller, switch, motor, LED, sparkle, crocodile clips, connect, battery box, program, condition, input, selection, action, repetition, debug.

Science

We are going to be looking at forces during this term. We will be doing lots of wonderful experiments that investigate why we have different forces and what can affect them.



Key Vocabulary: forces, earth, gravity, friction, falling object, air resistance, water resistance, act, moving surface, mechanism, lever, pulley, gears, effort, push, pull, Galileo, Isaac Newton, theory of gravitation, springs, newton meter, weight, mass.

<u>Art</u>

This half term we are going to be creating art using recycled materials. Alongside this we will be exploring how we can intertwine different patterns and textures within our pieces.



Key vocabulary: Complimentary, abstract, figurative, watercolour, perspective, proportion, Impressionism, lino, texture, sustainability, recycling, upcycle, El Anatsui, Kat Flint, Brian Reedy

French

In French this term, we will be learning more about the French world! We will reconsolidate our knowledge around asking for and giving directions, whilst also looking at the places in the world that French is spoken and finding out more about them!

Key Vocabulary: Je vais à (I go to) Tu vas comment? (Where do you go?) Je vais en... (I go to), grave accent, acute accent

PSHE

In PSHE this half term,
we will be looking at
our overarching
question 'How can drugs common
to everyday life affect health?'.
Within this topic we will be
investigating how they can affect
us, organisations who offer support
and who to talk to if children have
any concerns.

Key vocabulary: Drugs, medicines addiction, support, risk, smoking, concerns, alcohol, caffeine, health, wellbeing.

Enrichment

In Enrichment, pupils generate patterns for creative proficiency, build good character, initiate an engaged mode for learning, and find purpose and interest in foundation subjects such as Food Technology, Art, Drama, Expressive Arts and Earth Adventures.
