

Useful notices

- We ask that the children are reading a minimum of 3x per week at home on **Active** Learn, your class teacher will allocate books (linked to the phonic sound) every Friday. We ask that each time your child reads it is documented in their Reading Record, this will be checked by the class teacher every Friday. This is a great way to communicate your child's reading progress.
- Maths Link Learning will be sent home every Friday on Google Classroom and should be completed by the **following Thursday** and handed in to the class teacher.
- Alongside this, spellings (linked to the phonic sounds) will be handed out every Friday, these need to be practised at home ready for the children to complete a 'spelling quiz' the following Friday.
- P.E day will be on Monday. Both 1L and 1T have PE on a Monday this half term. Children are required to come in full PE kit on this day (please see school website for correct Lime Tree P.E kit).
