











Year 6 Curriculum Newsletter

Please find below an outline of Year 6's curriculum for the Summer 2 term. If you have any questions regarding the curriculum this half term, please do not hesitate to speak to one of the team.



<p>History</p> <p>Throughout the summer term, we will be continuing our local history study. Our enquiry question for the topic is, "How did the Industrial Revolution change Manchester". We have learned about living and working conditions and will now move on to how these changed as well as the political changes which came into place during this time.</p>	<p>English</p> <p>This half term, we will be using Emma Carroll's 'Sky Chasers' fictional tale as the inspiration for our writing. We will be spending lots of time reading our script too as we prepare for the production, Aladdin!</p> 	<p>Maths</p> <p>This half term, we will continue a variety of maths application projects where we apply our mathematical skills and knowledge to completing an assignment.</p> 
<p>Music</p> <p>Our musical learning will largely be made up of learning the soundtrack to the Broadway musical, Aladdin. We have begun to add texture to the pieces of music by varying the dynamics in different phrases. We will continue this in readiness for our production of Aladdin!</p> 	<p>Religious Education</p> <p>In R.E this half term, we will be investigating the big question: What do religions say to us when life gets hard? We will continue to unpick religious and philosophical terminology and concepts to explain religious beliefs and values.</p> 	<p>Physical Education</p> <p>We are excited to announce that once again, another professional organisation will be coaching Year 6 to develop their physical educational skills. This half term, Sale Sharks will be delivering Tag Rugby lessons and will aim to ensure the children know key interception tactics, good team communication skills and develop their overall fitness.</p> 
<p>Science</p> <p>Not only will we take part in The Great Science Share during Summer 2, we will also continue learning about electricity to determine how circuits work, what causes circuits to break and how we can achieve more sustainable means of generating electricity.</p> 	<p>Computing</p> <p>In Computing this half term, we will be learning how to create spreadsheets to help us more easily interpret data and information. We will use Excel and Google Slides to create the spreadsheets.</p> 	<p>Design and Technology</p> <p>In Design and Technology this half term we will be designing and making automated toys. We will cut wood, assemble components based upon a design and create an automata toy frame. Our finished products might look something a little like this:</p> 



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<p><u>French</u> In French, we will be planning a holiday! Look out for the knowledge organiser for a head start in learning some of the key vocabulary needed to plan a holiday.</p> 	<p><u>PSHE</u> This term, our PSHE lessons will focus upon the reproductive process, growing up and the changes we experience, changing friendships and transitions to secondary school. There are lots of important conversations to be had this term in PSHE. Please do not hesitate to get in touch with school if there is a particular area regarding transition that your child may have worries about.</p>	<p><u>Enrichment</u> In Enrichment pupils generate patterns for creative proficiency, build good character, initiate an engaged mode for learning, and find purpose and interest in foundation subjects such as Food Technology, Art, Drama, Expressive Arts and Earth Adventures.</p>

- Spellings will be shared on Google Classroom and with the children each week. There will be a spelling test every Friday. Please support your child by practicing their spellings with them.
